<u>City Council Update</u>

Mayor Pam VanArsdale opened the March City Council meeting with an Invocation from Pastor Bob McKenzie from Foots Creek Chapel, hearing committee reports from the City Council and an update on the recent short legislative session regarding voter's annexations.

The following are agenda items that the City Council took action on:

- * Approved an Ordinance amending the storage of motor vehicles on City streets
- * Approved an Ordinance regulating **Recreational Marijuana Sales in** the City
- Approved an Ordinance regulating * temporary signs in the City limits
- Approved a Resolution that * established a fee for all Marijuana related businesses
- Approved a Resolution that established a fee for reviewing Land Use Compatibility Statements (LUCS)
- Approved a Resolution making appropriations for unanticipated funding for a Grant received for the riparian planting work being done at John F. Fleming Memorial Park
- Approved a Resolution for applying * for the 2016 Special City Allotment from East Main to First Street and First Street from Pine to Broadway Streets
- Approved a Resolution adopting a Continuity of Operations Plan



- * Authorized the Mayor to sign Continuity of Operations Plan Memorandum of Understanding Agreement for the use of facilities and resources during a Local Emergency with the Jackson County Library District
- Authorized the Mayor to sign an * Intergovernmental Agreement with the Rogue River School District to remit Construction Excise Tax generated from City building permits
- Authorized the Mayor to sign an * **Oregon Liquor Control License for** a change of ownership at Bee Gee's Diner
- ÷ Authorized the Mayor to sign an Oregon Liquor Control License for a new outlet for on premise sales for the Rogue Burrito
- Approved a \$500 donation to * sponsor the Elk Mountain Games and May Day Festival
- * Approved a request to hang a banner for the Elk Mountain Games and May Day Festival
- * The Mayor read a Proclamation that will be presented at the Arbor Day Festivities on Thursday, April 7th 2016
