"City Council's Update"

Last month's City Council meeting began with Mayor Ryan Hess welcoming Pastor Scott Purrier with the Evans Valley Bible Church who delivered the Invocation. Following the Pledge of Allegiance Committee Reports were heard from the individual City Councilors. The following items were handled during the meeting:

Adopted a Resolution certifying the municipal services provided by the City of Rogue River, Oregon, for the 2019-2020 budget year.

Adopted a Resolution extending Workers' Compensation coverage to volunteers of the City of Rogue River, Oregon, for the 2019-2020 budget year.

Adopted a Resolution declaring the City's election to receive State Revenue Sharing for the City of Rogue River, Oregon, for the 2019-2020 budget year.

Adopted a Resolution authorizing the funds to be used in the financial management of the City of Rogue River, Oregon, for the 2019-2020 budget year.

Adopted a Resolution adopting the budget, making appropriations, and levying taxes for the City of Rogue River, Oregon, for the 2019-2020 budget year.

Approved Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement between the City and State of Oregon, Department of Transportation to extend time and update contacts.

Adopted a Resolution approving an agreement authorizing the City of Rogue River, Oregon, to participate in a cost sharing arrangement with the Oregon

Department of Transportation (ODOT) for specific transportation projects related to Interstate-5 alternative mobility standards.

A request for an Oregon Liquor Control Commission Liquor License Application for limited on-premises service for the Depot Street Grill at 121 Depot Street: Applicant: Eric Fortner, Owner, failed due to a second motion and the application was denied.

Approved a request from Mike Hammond with the Rogue River Professional Firefighters Association Local 3513 to hold their annual "Fill the Boot" drive for Muscular Dystrophy on Saturday, June 8, 2019.

Approved a request from Jacob Maris with the Rogue River High School Leadership Club to hold a concert in Palmerton Park Arboretum on June 1, 2019 and to waive the park reservation fee
